PLACE: East Aurora High School

WHEN: Friday, May 4th, 2018 at 4:30 P.M.

CELEBRATIONS: We will be doing our Senior Night for our Senior track athletes at 4:30, that will be followed by a recognition of all former Kane County Champions. If you have any former champions from your school who may be interested in attending they will be given free entry and will be recognized at 5:00 PM we would love to have them join us on this historic night.

SCRATCHES: All coaches are to report to the Press Box to pick up meet packets and make any necessary scratches. Please try and do this before 4:00. We will have a coaches meeting at the start/finish line at 4:15.

DRESSING FACILITIES: Please bring your athletes ready to participate since no dressing facilities will be available.

AREA FOR ATHLETES: Camps with tents may be set up in grassy area east of the track next to the bus lane. You may also set up camps in visitor or home bleachers; we simply ask that the two northern most sections of the home bleachers (closest to the finish line) are reserved for spectators. No spikes on the bleachers please.

WEIGH INS: Shot & discus will be checked in prior to 4:00 by the finish line. Please be sure that you have a legal implement that meets IHSA specifications.

STARTING BLOCKS: East Aurora High School will provide all starting blocks.

CHECK-IN: Athletes will check at the near the north goalpost. There will be a staging area with benches near the starting line where the clerk will take athletes to the starting line for their races.

PLEASE DO NOT PLACE ANY TAPE ON THE TRACK SURFACE. THIS INCLUDES ALL RUNWAYS WE WILL PROVIDE CHALK.

LIMITATIONS: Each school is limited to two contestants in each track and field event.

ENTRIES: Entries will be made on Athletic.net by 9:00 AM on Wednesday May 2nd.

WORKERS: All schools will be expected to bring two able bodied workers. please email names and preferences to sgillespie@d131.org & bwilliams01@d131.org by 9:00 AM on Wednesday May 2nd.

STARTING HEIGHTS: Starting height for the high jump and pole vault will be determined at the coaches meeting.

SCORING: Points will be scored: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 (8 places)
Freshman Sprint Medley is Non-Scoring.

AWARDS: Trophies will be awarded the top 3 teams and individual medals will be awarded to the first 8 place winners in each event.

CONCESSIONS: The Aurora East Booster Club will have the concession stand open throughout the day.
