Buses

Schools must arrive before 2:00 or after 2:40. There will be no access to the parking lot between 2:00 and 2:40 due to school dismissal.

Buses should drop off at the athletic entrance door #1. Teams will walk back along the drive to the track. No buses may park in the school lots. Bus parking is in the gravel lot across Red Gate Road (at Red Gate just west of Route 31).

Admission

Admission is \$5.00 for all spectators. No passes accepted.

All spectators, athletes, and coaches are reminded to display good sportsmanship. Mechanical noise makers, musical instruments, etc. are not allowed.

Concessions

In case of inclement weather we will use the lunch room and/or small gym at St. Charles North as a recovery area. If necessary, the make-up date for the meet is Saturday May 19th.

Check In

Pole Vaulters will be weighed inside of door #51 by the track entrance between 3:15 and 3:45.

Shots and discs will be weighed between 3:15 and 3:45 near the finish line.

Team packets will be available in the press box.

Scratches will be made in the press box. Substitutions per IHSA rules only.

Results will be posted near the concession stand. Results will be copied at the end of the meet and available outside of door #51. Results will also be online at pttiming.com.

Facilities

Teams may set up camps outside of the main stadium along the south side. Please do not camp in the south or middle sections of the main bleachers, nor near the pole vault pit.

Athletic training will be available near the finish line.

Bathrooms are available in the concession stand building.

There are no locker rooms available.

No athletes should enter the building nor be in the equipment area behind the main bleachers.

Specific Time Schedule

3:15 to 3:45 *Pole Vault Weighing*. Inside Door #51

Athletes weighed in uniform with all vaulting items (spikes, helmets, etc...)

Shot and Discus weighing near the finish line

3:30 to 4:00 Scratches made in Press Box

4:15 Head coaches and captains meeting at finish line

FIELD EVENTS

4:30 **Discus** Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order), then finals
Three throws, top 9 to finals for 3 more throws
15 minute warm up prior to each flight

Shot First flight of shot warms up when flight 3 of discus begins
Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order), then finals
Three throws, top 9 to finals for 3 more throws
15 minute warm up prior to each flight

Long Jump* Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order) then finals in North D-zone, south runway
Three jumps, top 9 to finals for 3 more jumps
15 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight

Triple Jump* First flight of triple begins when flight 3 of long begins
Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order) then finals in North D-zone, north runway
Three jumps, top 9 to finals for 3 more jumps
10 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight

*In case of significant North-South wind, games committee can choose to use N-S long/triple pit.
N-S pit does not have wood boards.

High Jump Best Flight first
Opening Height (for both flights): 5-4 up by 2"
15 minute warm up between flights

Pole Vault Best Flight first
Opening Height (for both flights): 8-0 up by 6"
15 minute warm up between flights
