- 5. All spectators must complete the Google Sheet created by the WN coaching staff to indicate their planned attendance. This should be <u>limited to parents and family members</u>. This sheet will be sent out to visiting schools and WN parents by WN at least the day before each event. This should be completed by both home and away parents.
